About Meniere's disease and other Vestibular Disorders

Living with an invisible vestibular disorder like Meniere's disease impacts on quality of life. People with Meniere's are likely to become isolated, partly because of hearing problems and also because of anxiety about having an attack in public which may involve severe dizziness or vertigo, vomiting and diarrhoea.

Research shows that the major impacts on the lives of people living with the Meniere's are:

- Limitations to access employment
- Restrictions on the ability to travel
- Limited ability to pursue interests and hobbies
- Restrictions on type of foods that can be enjoyed
- Fear of a full blown vertigo attack in public
- Fear of misunderstanding by the community
- Anxiety and depression
- Stress
